

## General Information and Rules

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<b>Entry Fees</b>	Grounds Fee: \$25.00 / rider Pre-entry: \$12.00 / class \$35.00 / division Day of show: \$15.00 / class \$42.00 / division
	Non-showing horses are subject to grounds fee. For money classes and leadline please see class definitions for entrance fee.
	Pre-entries, accompanied by signed checks, must be received by 8pm on the Friday before the show. If paying at the end of the show day, please leave a signed open check at the registration booth.
<b>Classes</b>	Age will be determined by Jan 1, 2017. Judges' decisions are final.
	Modifications must be made at the registration booth before the class in question. Please notify management of upcoming ring conflicts so that, if possible, a solution may be found.
	Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes, or to modify the definitions of divisions and classes in any way.
	All classes place 1 <sup>st</sup> through 6 <sup>th</sup> . Prizes will be awarded to the champion and reserve for each division. Divisions with less than three riders in each class will not receive a champion and reserve for the day. All competitors will automatically be signed up for year end awards.
<b>Banquet</b>	Year end awards for both Hunter Jumper and Dressage Schooling Shows will be presented Friday Nov 3 <sup>rd</sup> during the annual Creekside Awards Banquet at Chestnut Ridge Golf Resort and Conference Center, 132 Pine Ridge Rd, Blairsville, PA. Registration forms to be available at the shows, online, or upon request.
<b>Refunds</b>	Refunds will be granted until 10 AM of show day, minus a \$10 office fee.
	Any unsportsmanlike conduct, unsafe riding, or mistreatment of horse or pony, may result in expulsion from the show grounds, without refund of entry fees.

<b>Food</b>	Breakfast and lunch concessions will be available on the show grounds.  Please join us during Friday schooling for a free Hotdog Picnic at the concession stand.
<b>Camping</b>	Friday evening campers are gladly accepted in designated parking areas.
<b>Lodging</b>	The Hampton Inn (724-459-5920) and Blairsville Inn (724-459-7100) are located less than 10 minutes west of the show grounds.
<b>Schooling</b>	Please wear contestant numbers during schooling. Contestants must register and sign appropriate entry forms before a number will be released.  Grounds open and schooling is permitted in both rings from 3 PM until dark on the Friday before the show. Please note schooling in Ring 2 on Fri, Jul 14 may be delayed until conclusion of Fix My Round Clinic. An EMT will not be on grounds until start of show.  Schooling is permitted on the morning of the show until 8:45 AM. From 8:15-8:45 schooling may be limited in Ring 2 for competitors participating in classes 34-45. Schooling will be available during the show in the indoor and at scheduled schooling breaks.
<b>Stabling</b>	Stalls must be reserved by receipt of nonrefundable stall fee and will be offered on a first come, first serve basis. First bedding provided. Stall for show day.....\$30.00 Stall for night before and show day.....\$45.00
<b>Rules</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Negative Coggins required, and must be within 1 year. Coggins will be checked at random.</li><li>2. All horses must have yearly shots..</li><li>3. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.</li><li>4. All riders must wear an approved protective helmet with harness secured while mounted.</li><li>5. All riders must compete with show appropriate dress and tack specifications (refer to USEF rulebook).</li></ol>
